WHO: All campers ages 8-18; Counselors 19 years and up--

3) Camp age visitors are expected to participate and attend all camp activities while on site.

District Church Camp--This is a time for spiritual growth as well as fun and friendship. We ask you to come prepared to learn and to share God's love among all. Campers (children, youth, and adults) are expected to conduct themselves in a Christian manner following these guidelines:

- 6) Damage to camp property will be charged to those responsible.
- 7) Campers must be willing to participate in all camp related activities.
- 8) Campers must respect each other, the camp staff, and the facilities.
- 9) Campers may only leave the camp with an adult staff member.
- 10) Older youth campers will be asked to turn in their car keys after registration and unpacking.
